### **TROPHIES**

Todmorden Agricultural Society has a detailed Animal Welfare Plan in place and wish to remind exhibitors that they remain the keepers of the stock and are therefore responsible for the health and welfare of their animals and ensuring compliance with the latest regulations.

- Exhibitors must ensure animals have sufficient food and water and protection from extreme weather conditions.
- Tail docking must comply with current legislation.
- Sheep tagging must also comply with current rules.
