2. Entries must be delivered to a member of the Arts & Crafts Committee in the relevant marquee by 10am Saturday 17th June.
3. No exhibits will be accepted after 10am
4. The tent will be closed to the public from 11-12 for judging.
5. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry.
6. All exhibits must clearly display the section/competition class number ticket and the exhibitor must produce the duplicate ID at the time of collection.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring the correct section, number & ticket is attached to their exhibit.
8. Judges shall have the power to withhold, modify or enhance prizes according to the standard of entries.
9. The Judge's decision is final.
10. The tent will close at. 5.30pm & exhibits may be removed between 4.30pm & 5.30pm. Exhibits not collected by 6pm will be deemed abandoned and disposed of by the Committee.
11. Prize money will be paid on Saturday 17th June on production of the relevant duplicate of the exhibit's ID number.
12. Every care will be taken of exhibits but the Committee does not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or theft of any item entered.
13. No article may be entered in two classes.
14. No prize winning exhibit from a previous Todmorden Show may be re-entered.
15. Exhibitors in all classes must be amateurs.
16. A donation of 10% to Todmorden Agricultural Society is required in the event of any exhibit being sold.
