and finally handling

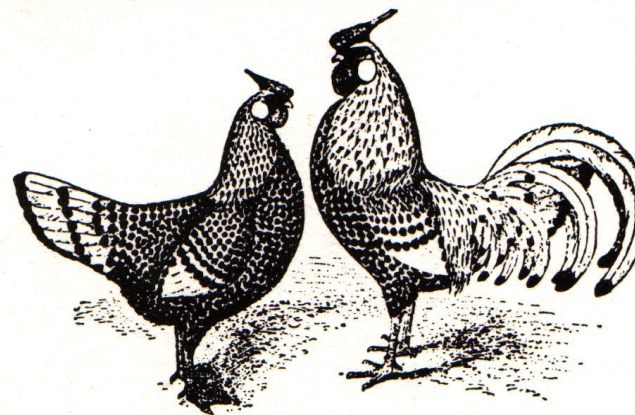
