Notes for Exhibitors:

- 1- Exhibitors must have public liability insurance.
- 2- Cattle passports and the recording of movements to Todmorden show is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- 3- Show holding number 21/076/8104
- 4- Cattle passports to be given to cattle secretary on arrival
- 5- Bulls must be handled in accordance with HSE Guidance Notes GS36 “safe custody of bulls at agricultural shows”
e.g. All bulls to have two handlers.
All bulls over the age of 10 months to be ringed
Or lead by bulldogs,
- 6- Cattle to be on the showground for 10.00 am
- 7- Cattle to remain on the showground until after the Parade of Cattle (approx 3 O’clock). When trophies And Prizes will be awarded.
- 8- Cattle must be tethered at the society’s standing
- 9- All Judges to be appointed.
- 10- The secretary may delete alter or amalgamate classes if there are insufficient entries on the day.
- 11- All persons 16 or under (Young Handlers) must be under the supervision of a responsible adult
